

SUMMARY REPORT
of the Budapest Case Handling Workshop
3-4 September, 2012

The Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information had the honourable task to host the Case Handling Workshop in September 2012, in Budapest. The agenda reflected the interests of the different national DPAs since we had asked for an active feedback. After reviewing the subjects of CHWs addressed over the past few years, we have come up with the following list of proposed topics:

Imposing Fines – European examples (Berlin/Germany, UK, Slovenia)

- Plenary II: Data Protection Audit

Audit Practices – European examples (Germany, Finland, Albania, Ireland)

- Alternative Session I:

Judicial Supervision of DPA Decisions (Czech Republic, Greece, Hungary)

CCTV and Voice Recording in Public Transport Areas (Belgium, UK, Hungary)

- Alternative Session II:

Processing of Personal Data in Connection with the Activity of Religious Associations
(Poland, Hungary)

Special Data Protection Issues Pertaining to AIDS/HIV Patients (roundtable discussion)

The CHW was attended by 52 participants representing numerous European DPAs and the EDPS.

The feedback received during the meeting and afterwards was very positive indeed.

According to the announcement of the relevant representative the next CHW will be organised by the DPA of Bosnia-Herzegovina in 2013.
